Ways you can help your child with literacy:

- Read with your child 3 times a week
- Practise the school letter formation
- Practise sound knowledge through writing simple words like cat, pin, frog, help etc
- Practice alien words eg Phonics play-Obb and Bob
- Write simple sentences about something they are interested in or something they have done with you
- Complete weekly homework

Ways you can help your child with numeracy:

- Counting to 10, to 20, to 100
- Practise number formation
- Use items around the home such as pasta or toy cars to add and take away up to 20, up to 50 etc
- Create number stories together e.g. There are 13 monkeys in the tree; 20 more monkeys join them. How many are there altogether?
- Spot maths in every day life e.g. shopping and the coins you would need
