

Forces Premium at Grange Infant School

We currently have 84 forces families on roll at the school and, as a school, think careful about the support and opportunities we can offer in school using 'Forces Premium'

We receive **£300** per child, per year, in terms of funding. **This funding is used collectively and not individually.**

As a Forces family you are entitled to:

Free breakfast club between 8.15 and 8.45am

Forces ELSA support sessions throughout the week where forces children spend time talking and sharing. There are also 1:1 ELSA sessions available for those children needing extra support. If you or your partner is on deployment your child will have chance to talk through their feelings, write letters and postcards to you.

Free entrance to Wednesday club between 3.15 and 5.30pm. (Year R spaces are offered from the spring term. This is to support wellbeing at the start of the year as it can be a very long day) your child will have the opportunity to spend time with forces friends and prepare and share a meal together. A range of themed craft activities are provided weekly for your child to enjoy.

Mrs Kennell, Mrs Sayer and Mrs Roberts run the provision for our Forces families and will be more than happy to talk through your child's provision with you. If you have any questions or queries, please do not hesitate to contact the school.
