Tuesday's 26-1-21 extra spelling challenge.

This week we are going to think about the rules for adding the suffix –ed to root words that have a short vowel sound before the last letter.

Can you explain to a grown up what a short vowel sound is? <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=-WSzS0-fmhQ> Watch this clip if you're unsure. (It's a YouTube clip so be careful as I can't control any pop ups. It was safe at the time of looking.)

Today's rule: Double the last letter if there's a short vowel sound just before it. Then just add –ed.

Today write the verb in the past tense. **Careful, I've mixed them up today so not all of the verbs have a short vowel sound in. Some words you just need to add -ed without doubling the consonant.**
