Hello Grange Infant School children and parents from Year R, 1 and 2

This week we have the theme of "Me and my Community"



Explain to the children that when someone says or thinks something nice about us, this is called a compliment. Some people can find it hard to accept compliments or believe them, but when someone says something nice it is always polite to say thank you and enjoy the nice feeling. What was the last compliment you received?

Talk about how it feels to receive positive comments and how different it feels to receive unkind comments.

Since we know it feels nice to receive appreciation from our friends, point out that it is important that we show others how special they are to us. Can you design and make some bunting flags for people in your community (thinking about a compliment they would like to receive).

E. g Thank - you refuse collector. You are such a valuable key-worker. You are so quick at collecting all of our rubbish, making our streets clean and tidy and safe for me to play.
