

Tuesday 23rd June – Guided Reading

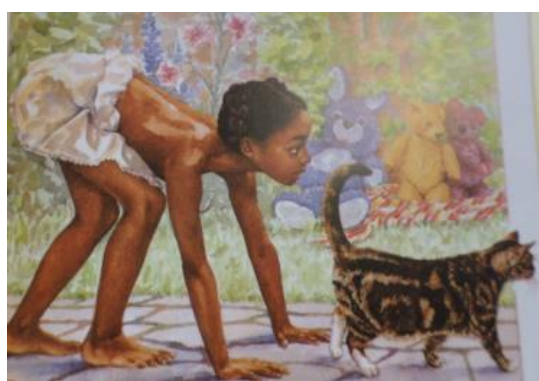
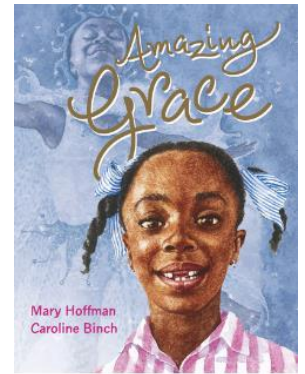
This week's theme is 'community' and we would like to focus on people and places. For the next 3 days we will be looking at the story 'Amazing Grace'.
