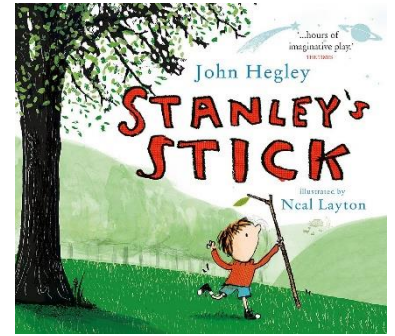


Tuesday 30th June – Guided Reading
