Today's focussed questions are...

- Explain something that happened in the middle of the story? (AF2.8)
- How is the main character feeling at the start/middle/end of the story? Why do they feel that way? (AF3.8)
- Find an example of a word you don't know the meaning of. Look at the text around it, what do you think it means? (AF5.8)

(It might be useful for you to keep a note of these questions for when the children have returned to school and you return to the usual home reading routine.)
