'The Enormous Turnip'

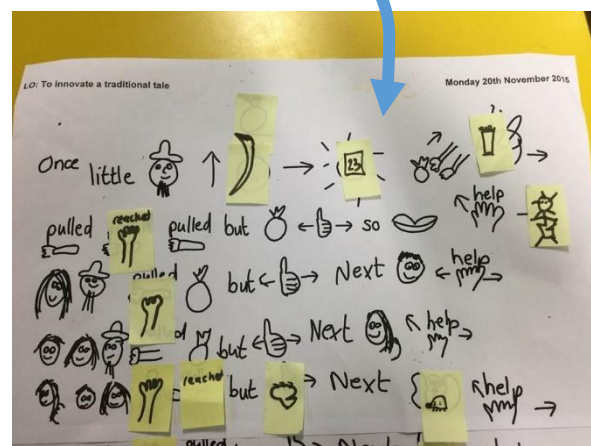


Task: Today we will be innovating the story of The Enormous Turnip. This means that we will be changing the story to our own version, for example, 'The Gigantic Banana'.
